Prior Learning:

Children have opportunities to explore pattern as part of teacher led activities and continuous provision in Reception.

Key Vocabulary taught in this unit:

weave, loom, warp, weft

Intent: What do we want the children to know, be able to do by the time they complete this unit)?

Know about the work of a range of artists, craft makers and designers, describing the differences and similarities between different practices and disciplines, and making links to their own work

Compare examples of woven art from a range of different cultures

Use a range of materials creatively to design and make products

Weave using a range of materials e.g. fabric, paper, wool, ribbon
Create their own woven art on both large and small scales

Develop a wide range of art and design techniques in using colour, pattern, texture, line, shape, form and space

Learn about the process of weaving and use the terms; loom, warp, weft.

Impact / Outcome:

What will the final product / result be?

After practising and mastering the technique of weaving, children will create a piece of patterned artwork by weaving fabric strips on a card loom.
