

Instrument of Government



The Governing Body of Crowthorne Church of England Primary School

1. The name of the school is Crowthorne Church of England Primary School.
2. The school is a voluntary controlled school.
3. The name of the governing body is:
“The Governing Body of Crowthorne Church of England Primary School.”
4. The governing body shall consist of:
 - 2 parent governors
 - 1 LA governor
 - 1 staff governor
 - 1 head teacher
 - 3 foundation governors
 - 6 co-opted governors
5. The total number of governors shall be 14, except that, at any time when the head teacher has given written notice to the clerk to the governors that s/he does not wish to be a governor, the total shall be 13.
6. Two foundation governors shall be appointed by the Diocesan Board of Education;
7. (a) The holder of the following office shall be a foundation governor ex officio:
The Vicar of Crowthorne

(b) The Archdeacon of Berkshire shall be entitled to appoint a foundation governor to act in the place of the ex officio foundation governor whose governorship derives from the office named in & 7 (a) above, in the event that that ex officio foundation governor is unable or unwilling to act as a foundation governor, or has been removed from office under regulation 21(1) of the Regulations or when there is a vacancy in the office named in 7 (a) above.


Instrument of Government



- (c) The Archdeacon of Berkshire shall be entitled to request the removal of the ex officio foundation governor named in 7(a) above and to appoint a substitute foundation governor.
8. The term of office of co-opted governors shall be two years.
9. The school was established by a trust deed dated 2nd November 1885.
10. Recognising its historic foundations, the School will preserve and develop its religious character in accordance with the principles of the Church of England, and in partnership with the Church at local and diocesan levels.
- The School aims to serve its community by providing an education of the highest quality within the context of Christian belief and practice. It encourages an understanding of the meaning and significance of faith and promotes Christian values through the experience it offers to all its pupils.
11. This instrument of government comes into effect on 8 December 2017.
12. This instrument was made by order of Bracknell Forest Borough Council on 1 December 2017.
13. A copy of the instrument must be supplied to every member of the governing body (and the head teacher if not a governor), any trustees and the Oxford Diocesan Board of Education.
